<p>TUI UK & Ireland</p>	<p>Customers will now be able to travel overseas on holiday following a new traffic light system with Green, Amber and Red destinations. TUI will only fly to destinations on the Green and Amber list and where the Foreign Commonwealth and Development Office travel advice allows. We are constantly reviewing our holiday programme and cancellations in line with the Government updates every three weeks.</p> <p>We expect the next Government update the first week of June, which will come into effect week commencing from 7th June 2021.</p> <p>Due to ongoing uncertainty, we have unfortunately had to cancel all holidays to the following Red and Amber destinations:</p> <p>All holidays to the Balearics, Mainland Spain, Cyprus, Italy, Croatia, Halkidiki, Kefalonia, Prevesa, Samos, Skiathos, Santorini, Thassos, Zakynthos, Crete (CHQ), La Palma, Tanzania, Jamaica, & Aruba are now cancelled up to and including 13 June 2021.</p> <p>Holidays to Mexico, the Dominican Republic, Costa Rica, Turkey, Egypt, Cape Verde, Morocco, Tunisia and Bulgaria are cancelled up to and including 27th June 2021.</p> <p>Our Lakes and Mountains programme is also cancelled up to and including 13 June 2021.</p>	<p>Holidays to the following Green & Amber destinations are currently operating:</p> <p>Green: Algarve (Faro), Madeira, Porto Santo Amber: Crete (Heraklion), Kos, Rhodes, Corfu, St Lucia, Cuba (Varadero) & Antigua.</p> <p>Destinations planned to operate:</p> <p>28 May: Gran Canaria 4 June: Tenerife: 5 June: Fuerteventura</p>
